Due to the taboo of sex and desire of FLINTA\* persons in our society it is not always easy to feel what we want and what gives us pleasure. In the workshop "Sex Positivity" we want to look at how patriarchal structures influence our experience of sex and what ways there are to break free from them. How can we learn sex that is not shaped by heteronormative practices? How do we get rid of the constant view of ourselves from the outside? What is my body in the context of the society I live in, and how can I work to free it from the projections of that same queer-hostile society?

Together, in a safer space, we will discover new experiments and ideas, learn strategies of mindful body awareness, and explore forms of (queer) sex.

This workshop is a safe space! You share only what you want to share!

Christine Nagl is a queerfeminist activist focusing on sex work and board member of sexworker.at. She describes herself as an "old, white woman with freckles, experienced and knowledgeable in the field of sexuality, whether in pay or non-pay." Christine Nagl unabashedly confronts the conservative and hypocritical public discourses surrounding sex work in Salzburg and throughout Austria.

#### Jenny Browne's Biography

I'm Jenny. I'm an educator, translator and poet living in Berlin. I studied creative writing in the UK, where I grew up, and have been performing with the Queerdos Collective since 2013. I led creative writing workshops in Hungary and Moldova for Queerdos ACTing Up. I help with the "Q Kollektiv", a monthly queer youth club for German teenagers.

In my workshops we use poetry as a tool to reach deeper levels of self-expression. My creative writing explores queer identity, intimacy, and mental health because I believe the spoken word is a powerful form of expression.
